

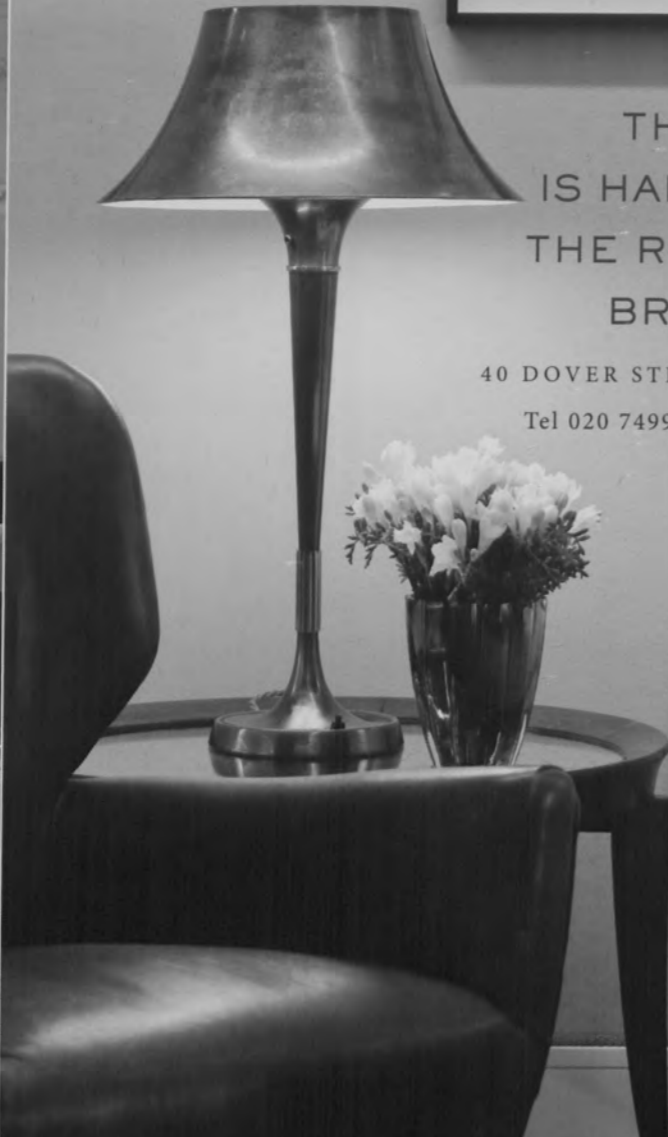

## Welcome from the President

For those visitors who regularly attend our exhibitions there will be many familiar subjects, locations and styles, painted by many familiar well known artists. Sitting in my studio as I write this, I am glancing around the walls, which are peppered with oil and watercolour paintings and may be getting slightly alarmed at the regularity of much of the subject matter. I then start wondering why so many of us Painters and Sculptors re-visit the same subject time and time again.

In my case, Walberswick, on the east coast and India are places that I have been painting in for many years. Likewise there will be many other of our members on show who have also been wrestling with and trying to delve deeper into subject matter in an attempt to not only understand more about the subject but the business and nature of creativity itself.

It is this aspect in particular that I personally find so deeply intriguing when I look around the show once it is hung. The idea of 'Theme and Variations' is well known within painting and music and an exhibition, such as ours, is a great opportunity to see this carried out by a distinguished group of artists in an exciting and varied way. Each year I look forward to seeing the latest versions of themes and ideas and how close the various artists have come to achieving their ambitions.

This has been a major part of what a large group show like the RBA has been exhibiting to the public for a good many years. However, it is also vital that we embrace new ideas and new blood, especially in the form of young artists.

Over the last few years we have been operating a scheme in association with NADFAS and the Dover Federation for the Arts to promote and encourage the work of young artists. This has been going from strength to strength, and this year the selection was harder than ever due to the wonderful response from schools and colleges around the country, resulting in an extremely high level of work to choose from. When the selection was complete it occurred to me that many of these pieces might well have got through the normal selection committee. As before, these young artists will be given the title of 'RBA Scholar' in recognition of their achievement.

Also, as in previous years, we will be conducting a series of demonstrations and workshops open to everyone during the exhibition. We are all of the belief that the more involvement the viewing public can have with the processes involved with creativity, the greater the understanding will be of what artists are trying to do. We are also of the belief that consummate skill and command of a medium will provide the best vehicle for expression. I hope that you will find this present in this 295th exhibition of the RBA.

Finally I would like to give my deepest thanks to all of the council members who have worked so hard to produce this excellent show and in particular to Roger Austin who works tirelessly throughout the year to maintain our website. In addition my gratitude and thanks to the De Laszlo family for their continuing loyalty to the society as indeed all thanks to the many prize givers who generously support us.

## The Rome Scholarship

As a result of a generous bequest from the late Mr. G H Benn in memory of his late wife Marianne Von Werther, a former member of the RBA, we are able to offer an annual scholarship to spend one month at the British School in Rome in July of each year. The main emphasis for this award is that the applicants should demonstrate a high standard in draftsmanship. Subject to Council approval, selected samples of work resulting from the stay in Rome may be shown at the annual exhibition.

The most recent RBA Rome Scholar is Lewis Hazelwood-Horner who has written a short account of his stay in the eternal city: "I had never been to Rome before and found it has so much to offer in terms of its architecture, cultural heritage, sculptures, paintings, people, street life. Because of this I will always want to return. I wanted to explore a different view of Rome so I focused my interest on an everyday aspect of life in Rome, in particular its market squares, gelaterias and bars. I found what I was looking for in the old part of the city near the Pantheon.

The British School became my home for four weeks this summer. It's a Lutyens building in a picturesque setting with great

accommodation and facilities conveniently situated adjacent to the Beaux Arts Gallery, on the edge of the Borghese Gardens. Each evening I would sit in the courtyard with the other artists and scholars and we would chat about our day. We talked late into the night discussing art and architecture. On days off I would play tennis with the other scholars. I am still in contact with many of the interesting people I met on the trip.

I am starting on the pathway to making painting my profession. The Marianne Von Werther Memorial Award/Rome Scholarship was a great opportunity for a young artist like myself; I thoroughly enjoyed the trip and would urge other artists to strongly consider applying for this scholarship because it is such a wonderful opportunity to be given by the RBA".

The Rome Scholarship is open to students finishing their degree at college. It is an enriching experience, aiming to extend knowledge and understanding of the arts in a different setting. ## Sad Farewells

The RBA has lost two treasured members since the last Annual Exhibition – Trevor Frankland and Selina di Girolamo.



Trevor Frankland RBA PPRWS RE Hon. RI (1931-2011) was an original and unusual artist with a sparkling sense of fun and great ability both as a painter and as President of the Royal Watercolour Society and Council Member of the RBA. Born in Middlesbrough he trained at the Royal Academy Schools in London. In 1957 he married Dorothy Southern,

later a fellow member of the RBA. There followed a successful career in teaching, painting and exhibiting, including a one-man show at the Gulbenkian Gallery in Newcastle, Birmingham University and Worcester City Art Gallery, but maybe the crowning achievement of Trevor's life was the publication of Simon Fenwick's 2009 biography 'Trevor Frankland: Between Clarity and Mystery'.

In an interview in 2005 he wrote: *"I describe my art as the persistence of the past, a combination of inner and outer worlds. I believe that the influence of the past on the present can be seen in every aspect of the world around us, from human thought to the structure of landscape. I am interested in the geometry of 'interior space' governed by memory and imagination, where images appear and disappear as in a crystal ball, but in the process create a curious perpetual present. Finding the appropriate forms so that these elusive images can have their own reality requires a combination of formal structure with descriptive detail."*

His wise counsel and cheerful personality will be greatly missed

The premature death of Selina di Girolamo RBA (1969-2011) shocked us all. After gaining a BA honour degree in Fine Art at Middlesex University, Selina embarked upon a successful career as an artist, writer and lecturer and election to the Buckinghamshire Art Society and the Royal Society of British Artists swiftly followed. She exhibited at

many galleries including Thompson's in London and appeared in a number of television programmes. In addition, she served on the Council of the RBA. Her experience and expertise in art education was confirmed when she was elected by representatives of member societies to chair the FBA Education Committee.

Her life and character is perhaps best summed up by her parents when they wrote: *"It was clear from early childhood that Selina was destined to be a special person with a mission to make the world a better place, when asked what she would like for her birthday she replied, "for the sun to shine and everyone to be happy". She was blessed with beauty, being able to express herself verbally, musically and visually but above all she possessed extraordinary psychic and persuasive powers."*

Selina was talented in so many areas of art and culture that her early death seems all the more distressing. We extend our sympathies to her husband Michael Fairclough, her three sons and her parents.
